## Swimming Pool

The swimming pool is almost ready to open. We hope to have it open within the next couple of weeks. The pool temperature is rising and the water looks inviting.

Once the Health Department inspects, we will be able to open. The pool will be open from 10am to 5pm and 6pm to 8pm daily.

### Swimming Pool Rules

- 1) No Swimming Alone
- 2) No one under 18 allowed in the Pool without an Adult 18 years old or older
- 3) No Cut-off Shorts. Bathing Suits only
- 4) No Running or Rough Play
- 5) No Diving
- 6) No Profanity.
- 7) No Glass Containers
- 8) No Alcohol allowed at the pool. No Exceptions.
- 9) Do not walk thru any campsite to get to the Pool. The entrance is in the grassy area behind the Storage Lot
- 10) No radios allowed at the Pool
- 11) Rinse at outside shower before entering the pool
- 12) Please eat all food under the shelter and away from the pool deck
- 13) Please keep all children from playing with the rocks and putting them in the pool. This can damage the pool
- 14) Monthly Campers will not need to have an armband for the pool. Any Visitors will need an Armband. Visitors can get these at the office
- 15) If there are Thunderstorms, the Pool will be closed for safety. It will reopen once it is safe.

## Electric Meters and Monthly Rates

I have held off on this as long as I could, but it was bound to happen. I'm sure I don't need to tell you that prices have gone up this year. We have added amenities to the park for your enjoyment and it cost a lot to maintain them. The rates have not increased in 2 years. Please remember that this is a recreational park.

This year we have replaced 29 electrical boxes for 30 amp service. We will begin to install Meters at all of the extended stay campsites. Starting in October 2010 the rate for the monthly campsite will be \$350.00 for 30amp service and \$380.00 for 50amp service. This rate will include a certain amount of Electricity. Any electrical usage over the designated amount will be the responsibility of the tenant. The meters will be read once a month and the number recorded for each site.

If you have a TV receiver it will remain at \$22.00 a month. We are giving you this notice to give you plenty of time to make any necessary changes as we know this will impact everyone a little and no one likes these types of surprises. Please understand that this is a necessary change to keep the park in operation. Again we appreciate your cooperation with this matter and fill free to come and talk with us if you have any questions. Thank you.
